Reports

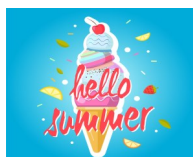

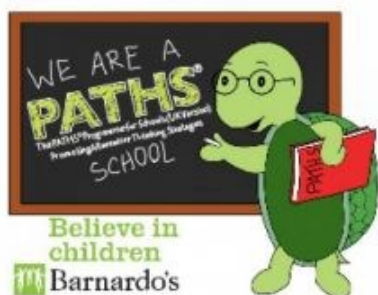

Music Tuition

A number of children will be offered the opportunity to take up musical instrument tuition. If a child is taking up woodwind, brass or string tuition in small group lesson there will be a tuition charge of approximately £150 (approximately £4.70 a lesson) and an instrument rental fee. This can be paid in two instalments, but the first instalment will be due mid September. This is waived if the child is entitled to Free School Meals.
