If you have any reading books, library books, numeracy or literacy text books, we would appreciate it if you would return them to your current class teacher.

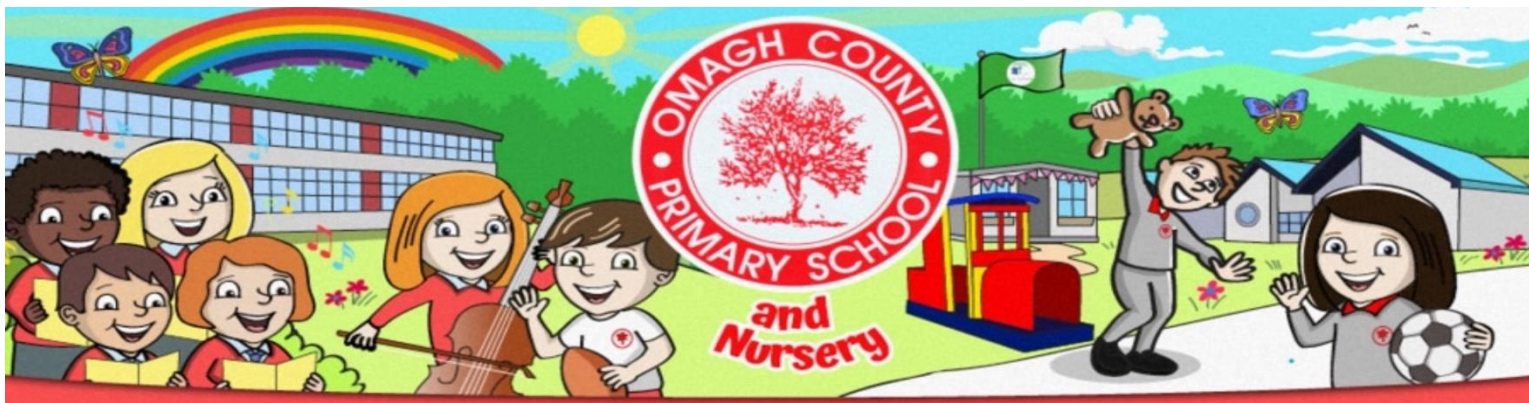
